

Wood Preservation Risk Management

- Environment Canada chose to develop a voluntary risk management instrument; the <u>Technical</u> <u>Recommendations Document (TRD)</u> developed under the Canadian Environmental Protection Act (CEPA)
- Developed in collaboration with federal and provincial government agencies, the wood preservation industry, forest industry labour unions, and workers' compensation boards.
- In 2013, Environment Canada published the latest revision of the TRD

Technical Recommendations Document (TRD)

- Also known as the Recommendations for the Design and Operation of Wood Preservation Facilities, 2013
- Main objectives of the TRD are to provide recommendations to industry:
 - Reduce or eliminate the release of wood preservative chemicals to the environment
 - Minimize the exposure of workers to wood preservative chemicals
- TRD recommends best management practices to reach those objectives on:
 - Design of the facilities and equipment
 - Operational practices

TRD compliance

- Pesticides are regulated by the <u>Pest Management</u> <u>Regulatory Agency</u> (PMRA), the branch of Health Canada that administers the <u>Pest Control Products Act</u>.
- Since 2013, the PMRA's pesticide labeling requirements for heavy duty wood preservatives (HDWP) refers to Environment Canada's Technical Recommendations Document (TRD).
 - Users must be in compliance with TRD recommendations when manufacturing treated wood.
 - HDWP: Creosote, PCP, ACZA, CCA
